


# Make your own Weather Vane!




Things you need :

- · A piece of clay
- A square piece of cardboard/thick paper

- A pencil with a fresh eraser (at the back)
- A pin
- · A straight straw
- · Coloured paper
- · A pair of scissors
- · Markers or crayons



## <u>Step |</u>:

Mark the four directions, North, South, East and West, on the square piece of cardboard/thick paper.




### <u>Step 2</u> :

Cut two slits, directly opposite to each other at each end of the straw.

#### <u>Step 3</u> :

Cut an arrow head and a tail out of the coloured paper. Slip them into the slits that you made on the straw.



### <u>Step 4</u> :

Place the piece of clay at the centre of the square piece of cardboard/thick paper. Stick the pointy end of the pencil into the piece of clay. Make sure that the pencil is stable.



#### <u>Step 5</u> :

Poke the pin through the centre of the straw. Once the pin is attached to the straw, poke the pin into the eraser on the back of the pencil. Make sure that the arrangement is stable. Also ensure that the straw can easily rotate on the pin.

Your weather vane is ready! Use it to find out the direction of the wind.
