### Did you know?

- It is the 17th largest constellation and one of the 42 that represents an animal. In Latin Taurus means bull.
- Taurus is visible through the autumn and winter months in the northern hemisphere and from late spring and throughout the summer in the southern hemisphere and will appear upside down.
- The red giant Aldebaran is the brightest star in this constellation. It is over 500 times brighter than the sun and can be spotted as the eye of the bull.
- Taurus includes the intersection of the galactic and celestial equator and the ecliptic; the only constellation to contain such an alignment.
- According to Greek mythology, when Zeus fell in love with the Phoenician Princess Europa, he transformed himself into a white bull with golden horns named Taurus and carried her away.
