Did you know?

- Gemini is one of the 88 constellations within the celestial sphere, and one of the 17 that represents a mythical character.
- In Latin, Gemini means twins. In Greek mythology, Gemini represents the twins Castor and Pollux.
- It is a northern constellation, and lies between Taurus in the west and Cancer in the east.
- The Gemini configuration is formed of four main stars of which Pollux remains the brightest.
- The Gemini constellation reaches its highest point in the sky in February.
- In the second week of December, one can observe meteor showers from the Gemini constellation. These are known as Geminids.
