Did you know?

- Alliums are a member of the onion family. Their name means 'garlic' in Latin.
- Edible alliums include onions, shallots, leeks, garlic, and chives.
- Allium species are characterised by pungent linear leaves and flowers with six petals.
- The colours of the allium flowers range from deep purple and blues to whites and greens.
- These versatile vegetables are high in beneficial sulfur compounds, giving them their distinctive flavor and aroma.
- Their antioxidant, antiviral, and antibacterial properties prevent blood clots; they are anti-inflammatory, immune-boosting, and potentially anti-ageing.
