### DID YOU KNOW?

- Scientifically, there is no colour black. It just means there is absolutely no light or absorption of light.
- Black was one of the earliest colours used in ancient art. Humans made charcoal by burning bones and then used those to draw.
- For ancient Egyptians, black meant fertility, as the rich soil of the Nile was in this colour. It was the colour of Anubis, the god of the underworld.
- The colour represents evil and darkness. The term black magic was used to indicate association with the devil or evil spirits.
- "In the black" means to be profitable. Earlier, accountants would use red ink to mark losses and write profits in black ink.
- In military parlance, black ops means secret and covert missions. Governments also refer to budgets for secret operations as black budgets.
