DID YOU KNOW?

- Natural indigo dye is extracted from the leaves of the Indigofera plant.
- In the Middle Ages, indigo dye from India was a prized trading commodity, and it was called 'blue gold'.
- The oldest indigo-dyed fabric in the world is an approximately 6,000-year-old woven cotton material discovered in Peru.
- Indigo dye is used to dye denim cloth, which is used to make classic blue jeans.
- Tyrian purple, an ancient dye closely related to indigo, was extracted from Mediterranean sea snails.
